Natural Cycle IVF:

Please note – the cycle fees detailed below do not include fees for sedation (£230), HFEA fee (£75), blood tests, ICSI or IVM. These are charged separately. These additional charges also apply to 3 cycle packages.

Natural natural cycle IVF:	£1950
<i>Includes monitoring scans, clinical advice, egg collection, embryology, embryo transfer, and blastocyst culture (where appropriate) and early pregnancy scan. One session of supportive counselling is included.</i>	
<i>Please note – an additional charge of £300 will be raised for modified natural IVF cycles</i>	

Natural cycle IVF – 3 cycle package:	£5265
<i>Includes monitoring scans, clinical advice, egg collection, embryology, embryo transfer and early pregnancy scan. You are entitled to a maximum of three cycles, however once a clinical pregnancy (fetal heart beat) is present, you will not be entitled to further cycles within this package. Three cycles should be completed within 12 months. One session of supportive counselling is included per cycle. Please note, in the event of abandoned cycle prior to egg collection, an abandoned cycle fee relating to the number of scans performed is applicable.</i>

Stimulated IVF:

Please note – the cycle fees detailed below do not include fees for sedation (£230), HFEA fee (£75), blood tests, ICSI or IVM. These are charged separately. These additional charges also apply to 3 cycle packages.

Mild Stimulation (also called Soft or Lite) IVF: *daily dose and duration of drugs is significantly lower with this type of IVF compared to conventional IVF. There is no ovarian suppression.*

Conventional Stimulation IVF: *Ovarian suppression followed by higher doses of stimulation.*

IVF – 3 cycle package:	£7995
<i>Includes monitoring scans, clinical advice, egg collection, embryology, embryo transfer and early pregnancy scan. You are entitled to a maximum of three cycles, however once a clinical pregnancy (fetal heart beat) is present, you will not be entitled to further cycles within this package. Three cycles should be completed within 12 months. One session of supportive counselling is included per cycle. Insemination treatments:

IUI: £700

Includes monitoring scans, clinical advice, sperm preparation, insemination procedure and early pregnancy scan. One session of supportive counselling is included.

IUI – 3 cycle package: £1890

Includes monitoring scans, clinical advice, sperm preparation, insemination procedure and early pregnancy scan. You are entitled to a maximum of three cycles, however once a clinical pregnancy (fetal heart beat) is present, you will not be entitled to further cycles within this package. Three cycles should be completed within 12 months. One session of supportive counselling is included per cycle. Please note, in the event of abandoned cycle prior to egg collection, an abandoned cycle fee relating to the number of scans performed is applicable.

Ovulation induction/monitoring (charge per scan): £175

Embryo, egg and sperm freezing:

Please note – embryo and egg freezing are performed by vitrification.

Embryo freezing: £100

Egg Freezing: £2650

Includes monitoring scans, clinical advice, egg collection, egg freezing by vitrification. One session of supportive counselling is included.

Sperm freezing: £150

Annual storage fee for eggs, embryos and sperm: £250

Per annum from the date of freeze.

Frozen embryo transfer procedure: £950

Includes monitoring scans, clinical advice, thawing and further culture of embryos, embryo transfer procedure and early pregnancy scan. One session of supportive counselling is included.

Please note – the frozen embryo transfer procedure fee does not include the HFEA fee (£75). This is charged separately.

In the event that a frozen embryo transfer cycle does not result in suitable embryos to transfer the fee is: £650

Sperm donation UK:

Please note – donor sperm can be used in Natural/modified natural cycle IVF, stimulated IVF, or IUI procedures – refer to the relevant treatment option for cycle fees.

Create Health works with several UK and overseas sperm banks. The cost of donor sperm varies and is payable directly to the sperm bank. You should estimate between £420 and £800 to purchase donor sperm.

HFEA fee for donor sperm in IUI cycle: £37.50

Only applies to use of donor sperm in IUI cycle.

Sperm donation overseas:

Create Health has formed a collaborative link with Copenhagen Fertility Centre to provide UK patients with natural cycle IVF treatment using donor sperm. Create Health will perform the initial aspects of treatment with Copenhagen Fertility Centre providing the donor sperm and performing the egg collection, embryology and embryo transfer.

Natural cycle satellite (European sperm donation): £800

Create Health's charge includes baseline monitoring scan, 2 x monitoring scans, communication of scans and blood results to Copenhagen Fertility Centre. Blood tests and medication are charged additionally. Services provided by Copenhagen Fertility Centre will be charged directly to you.

Egg donation, egg sharing and surrogacy UK:

Please note – the cycle fees detailed below do not include fees for sedation (£230) or HFEA fee (£75). These are charged separately.

Egg donation/sharing registration fee: £300

Applicable for all recipients joining UK or overseas waiting lists – non refundable.

Egg donation cycle (stimulated IVF): £4950

Includes monitoring scans for both recipient and donor, clinical advice, egg collection from the donor, embryology, embryo transfer to recipient and early pregnancy scan. One session of supportive counselling is included.

Please note – the above fee does not include the HFEA fee (£75). This is charged separately. Implications counselling is mandatory for both donor and recipient and is charged separately.

Egg sharing cycle (stimulated IVF): £4950

Includes monitoring scans for both recipient and donor, clinical advice, egg collection from the donor, embryology, embryo transfer to recipient and early pregnancy scan. One session of supportive counselling is included.

Please note – the above fee does not include the HFEA fee (£75). This is charged separately. Implications counselling is mandatory for both donor and recipient and is charged separately. Please refer to our egg sharing information sheets for more detailed fees.

Surrogacy cycle (stimulated IVF): TBA

Includes monitoring scans for both egg provider and host, clinical advice, egg collection from the provider, embryology, embryo transfer to host and early pregnancy scan. One session of supportive counselling is included.

Please note – the above fee does not include the HFEA fee (£75). This is charged separately. Implications counselling is mandatory for both commissioning couple and host and is charged separately. The case will be presented before our Ethics Committee and is charged separately.

ICSI (in addition to cycle fee): £950

Egg donation overseas:

Create Health has formed collaborative links with overseas treatment centres to provide UK patients with egg donation treatment services. Create Health will perform the initial aspects of treatment with the overseas treatment centres performing the donor recruitment, egg collection, embryology and embryo transfer.

Egg donation/sharing registration fee: £300
Applicable for all recipients joining UK or overseas waiting lists.

Egg donation satellite (overseas) per cycle: £1500
Create Health's charge includes consultation, injection lesson, monitoring scans, communication of scans and blood results, early pregnancy scan. Services provided by the overseas treatment centres will be charged directly to you.

Blood tests:

Prior to undergoing treatment, all egg and sperm providers are required to receive screening for infectious diseases. Egg donation, egg sharing, sperm donation and surrogacy treatments require more detailed screening. Some of these tests may be available through your GP. Screening results will only be accepted if the result is within 12 months of the egg collection/procedure.

Various hormone profiles will be necessary prior to starting treatment and throughout treatment.

Payment for services provided by Create Health Limited are required in full before commencement of the treatment or service. We reserve the right to cancel treatment if payment has not been received.

Payments for treatment including IUI, IVF, ICSI, egg donation, egg sharing, surrogacy must be received no later than on the day of the first monitoring scan.

The Clinic requires advanced payment for consultations, and if less than 48 hours notice of cancellation is given, no refund will be given.

All procedures requiring intravenous sedation anaesthesia will be subject to an additional charge.

Stimulated IVF/ICSI, FET, Egg Donation (both UK and overseas), egg sharing and surrogacy cycles which are not successful are entitled to a free follow-up consultation within six months of the negative result.

Blood tests and medication are charged separately and are not included within the treatment fees. Required laboratory tests, scans and medication are dependent on medical situation and vary from one person to another.

If you are taking advantage of our 3 cycle package a contract needs to be signed before the first cycle.

Drugs are not returnable or refundable.

All prices are in pounds sterling.

The Clinic accepts cash, credit cards, debit cards and bankers drafts. **There is a 2% charge for payments made by credit card.**

The clinic is unable to accept personal cheques, except for annual storage payment.

Create Health is setting up an interest free loan scheme for clients. A nominal charge is applied for this. Details are available on request
